CAPITAL CAMPAIGN REIGNITED AT ST. AMBROSE!

After much prayerful discernment, Fr. Fisher, the diocese and the Campaign Committee has decided to reignite the parish-wide capital campaign, ***It's Time to Build***, to raise the funds necessary to build our New Church. We need to have \$2,000,000 in pledges, not cash, by late May to be able to begin the building process.

Over the next two months, we will be reaching out to every parishioner to explain the project. We are planning to hold a number of campaign receptions this month. Two options are available in attending a reception, either in person at the parish hall or virtually.

Over \$800,000 has been pledged thus far!
