


OUR VISION











Beginning in the Fall of 2010, following extensive discussions, consultations with the Arlington Diocese, and town hall meetings with parish families and families of the neighborhood, the decision was made to move forward with a Master Plan to address the physical needs of St. Ambrose parish, with a particular focus on the construction of a new church.

In 2013, St. Ambrose Parish conducted a capital campaign to raise money toward the parish master plan. Since that time, the parish has worked extensively with the Arlington Diocese, our Architects, and Fairfax County to prepare for the demolition of the current rectory, the installation of additional parking, the demolition and re-construction of the parish church building. It has been a very involved, complex and multi-faceted process and we are very excited about the progress that has been made. There is still more to do. Included in this brocure is a sampling of the key achievements to date and the remaining tasks and timelines.

Total Funds Raised from Previous Campaign: \$3,300,000 2017 Building for our Faith Campaign Goal: ***\$3,000,000 Projected Loan from Arlington Diocese: ****\$7,500,000 - \$10,000,000

*** The money pledged during the 2017 Building for our Faith Capital Campaign will be included within the total amount of the loan from the Diocese of Arlington. The loan will allow the parish to move forward with Pre-Construction and Construction activities. As the pledges from the current campaign are paid, they will be directed toward future loan payments.

**** The total loan amount will be determined by both the need and the ability of the parish to make loan payments and maintain a cash flow over the course of the life of the loan.



^{*} The total project cost includes such soft costs as Architectural, Engineering, Legal, Consulting and County fees and expenses. Construction costs are also dependent on market costs for materials and labor.

^{**} Cost projections for the demolition of the current rectory and the installation of the new parking lot are represented through various soft cost estimates such as the civil and geotechnical evaluations, County review and approval of site plan, preconstruction clearing and site preparation, etc.


CAMPAIGN OVERVIEW

The parish community of St. Ambrose Parish would like to offer an opportunity for every parishioner to participate in our Building for our Faith Capital Campaign, and to support our parish needs. Through the involvement and generosity of all the members of our community, we will successfully reach our goal. Every parishioner is invited to attend a reception and learn more about the current progress and forthcoming steps in the next phase of our master building plan. All parishioners are asked to make a pledge by returning a completed pledge card. The success of our campaign depends on the participation and generosity of all our parish members. Throughout our campaign, every parishioner will be asked to:

- Reflect on how greatly God has blessed us as individuals and as a parish community.
- Give thanks to God for these blessings.
- Prayerfully consider how their involvement with this campaign can reflect their gratitude to God and our Church.

HOW TO PLEDGE YOUR SUPPORT

Every member of our parish community is integral to the future growth and development of our church, and therefore, each family is asked to consider a pledge to the campaign to the best of their ability. Our goal at St. Ambrose Parish is to raise \$3,000,000 through the efforts of this campaign. Everyone is asked to prayerfully consider how their generosity can reflect their gratitude for the gifts that God has given them. While any amount, small or large, is welcomed and will help us achieve our goal, each family is asked to consider a pledge of \$5,000 or more, payable over three years. A pledge of \$5,000, after a 10% down payment of \$500, is \$125 per month or \$4.11 per day.



WE ARE ALL MEMBERS OF A MUCH LARGER FAMILY

All of us are members of families who help each other in times of need. Here at St. Ambrose Parish we are also members of a much larger family, our faith community. Now we turn to you, our parish family, for assistance. Each family member, in his or her own special way, has been generous to our parish. Continuing that spirit of generosity, we request a pledge of financial and prayerful support from all our families. The gift plans in this brochure are provided as a suggested guideline when considering your pledge. Please review the gift plans carefully and select one that fits your household's financial ability. Payment amounts are calculated assuming a 10% down payment for each pledge.

AS YOU MAKE YOUR PLEDGE, PLEASE REMEMBER...

- Make checks payable to St. Ambrose.
- All donations made to this campaign will be deposited into the capital campaign fund and will be used exclusively for the case items presented in this brochure.
- Payments can be made over a period of three years or longer, if necessary.
- All contributions to the campaign are fully tax deductible for those who itemize their taxes.
- Pledge payments are in addition to your regular offertory. The Sunday offertory collection pays for the day-to-day operations of the parish, while your pledge in this campaign will be used specifically for capital campaign case items.
- Pledges are not legally binding, but rather an indication of your intention to donate.
- You may return the pledge card in the weekly collection, bring it by the parish office or return it in the mail.

GIVING OPTIONS

PLEDGES VIA CASH OR CHECK

Simply complete your pledge card by selecting the amount of your pledge and down payment (optional, but encouraged).

- Select your schedule of payment, i.e., monthly, quarterly, semi-annual or annual payments.
- Please make checks payable to St. Ambrose.
- Payment reminders will be mailed along with a special payment envelope in accordance with the plan you choose.
- Once completed, please return your pledge card in the weekly collection, bring it by the parish office or return it in the mail.

GIFTS OF STOCK

Donors can use their own broker/agent or the parish agent to transfer and sell stock.

- If the stock has been held long-term (over one year), the donor does not have to pay capital gains tax on the stock, and is allowed a tax deduction for the full value of the stock.
- Donors may also choose to sell stock in order to claim a loss, which may be beneficial for tax circumstances.
- In either case, the stock must first be transferred to the parish before being liquidated. Please contact the campaign office for more information.

Online Giving - Pledges Via Credit/Debit/Automatic Draft:

If you wish to make your pledge via credit, debit or automatic draft, please visit the St. Ambrose website – **www.stambroseva.org**

• Online Giving is a direct payment program whereby your contribution is debited automatically from your checking, savings, or credit card account into our church's bank account. Follow the instructions to either log in to an existing account or create a new account.

Gifts From Retirement Accounts:

The IRA Charitable Rollover provision of the 2015 PATH (Protecting Americans from Tax Hikes) Act permits individuals age 70.5 or older to contribute up to \$100,000 from a qualifying retirement account directly to St. Ambrose, without recognizing the assets transferred to the charity as income. Please contact your financial advisor for additional information concerning gifts via retirement accounts.

GIFTS OF LIFE INSURANCE, ANNUITIES, WILLS OR BEQUESTS

There are different ways to support St. Ambrose Parish both today and in the years to come via planned giving.

- Families or individuals can make gifts of real estate, personal property, automobiles, life insurance, estate bequests, annuities or charitable remainder trusts.
- For substantial gifts of property other than marketable securities

Federal and state laws on income and inheritance taxes encourage charitable giving. It may be particularly advantageous for some people to contribute stocks, appreciated securities, annuities, property or other valuables. In many cases, the tax savings may be more than your original investment in the gift. Because each situation is unique, we urge you to discuss such donations with a financial advisor.
