

**Sunday. June 18, 2023** 

Born in 1478, Saint Thomas More is most widely known for his steadfast refusal to support King Henry VIII's divorce & remarriage and the king's establishment of the Church of England. For this, he was beheaded on Tower Hill in 1535. In his final statement, he said he was "the king's good servant, but God's first", underscoring his refusal to deny his Catholic faith. More was canonized in 1935 and in 2000. Saint Pope John Paul II made him patron of political leaders. "The supreme diplomat and counselor, he did not compromise his own moral values in order to please the king, knowing that true allegiance to authority is not blind acceptance of everything that authority wants." He is also the patron saint of lawyers and public servants. His feast day is June 22. Saint Thomas More, pray for us! (ref. FransicanMedia.org)
