


#### Sunday, August 27, 2023

Saint Augustine was born in 354 in North Africa. He was an inquisitive & intelligent youth but set his sights on wealth & fame rather than spiritual needs. His mother, Saint Monica, never stopped praying for him though. It's her influence he credits with his conversion to Christianity and subsequent baptism at age 33. Following this, he wished to live a monastic life full of prayer, work, & fellowship. He later felt God calling him to be a priest and later was made bishop, despite a desire for a life of contemplation & separation from worldy concerns. Despite all his pastoral duties, he managed to write a prodigious amount: over 200 books and over a thousand letters & sermons. One of his most famous works is called Confessions. He is the patron saint of brewers, printers, & theologians. His feast day is August 28. Saint Augustine, pray for us! (Ref. Augustinian.org)
